

Board Goals 2017 – 2018

I. Student Achievement

- a. 65% of students in Grade 11 will demonstrate proficiency by exceeding College Readiness Standards in writing as measured by the MSTEP.
- b. 80% of students in grades K – 6 will demonstrate proficiency on DIBELS Next reading fluency assessment by the spring of 2018.
- c. 80% of students in grades K – 6 will demonstrate proficiency on DIBELS Math.
- d. The district will see a 5% increase over a (3) year period on the science MSTEP.
- e. The district will see a 5% increase over a (3) year period on the social studies MSTEP.

II. Graduation and Dropout Rates

- a. Maintain a graduation rate of 90% and above on the (4) year senior cohort.
- b. Obtain a 0% dropout rate on the (4) year senior cohort.

III. Finance

- a. Maintain a minimum fund balance of 12%.

IV. Visibility

- a. All school board members will attend as many school events as possible during the 2017 – 2018 school year.
- b. All school board members will spend (1) day in the district to visit classrooms, talk to staff, check on building conditions, etc.

V. Superintendent/School Board Member Relationships

- a. The superintendent will develop meaningful relationships with all board members and treat each board member with respect and dignity.
- b. All information that is sent out by the superintendent will be shared equally with all board members.
- c. The superintendent will communicate in a timely manner via email, text or phone call based on the severity of the situation.
